

## Worship Care Reentry---Babies-Kindergarten

We are so thankful for your family. As always, we are striving to keep your children safe while in our care at church. We want to continue to keep everyone healthy and safe. Thank you in advance for your understanding since there could be times of waiting. We look forward to seeing you in the weeks to come.

### **You should NOT come into the building if...**

1. You have had a fever of 100.4 degrees or higher in the last 24 hours.
2. You have any respiratory infections, or had had a cough, sneezing regularly, had shortness of breath, vomiting or diarrhea within the last 48 hours.
3. In the previous days, you have had any contact with someone: with a confirmed diagnosis of Covid-19; is under the investigation for Covid-19 or is ill experiencing a respiratory illness.
4. In the previous 14 days, you have traveled to any areas considered hot spots for Covid-19.

### **Upon Arrival:**

All staff, adults, and children will be screened with the four statements above.  
All Preschool volunteers will wear a mask when social distancing is not possible.

### **Drop off and Pickup Procedures:**

- The preschool lobby will be opened for childcare fifteen minutes before the service.
- Each child must have a reservation to be admitted into the classroom.
- Only one parent/guardian will be allowed in the preschool area for drop off and pick up (No siblings).
- Enter the Preschool lobby and exit at the opposite door.
- Check-in labels and vouchers will be printed for you so there is no need to access the check in stations.
- Please pick up your children immediately following the end of the service.

### **Preschool Area Procedures:**

- Hand sanitizer will be located at each doorway and inside the classrooms. When leaders and children enter the room, they will be asked to wash their hands or use alcohol-based gel.
- No diaper bags/tote bags of any sort should be sent with your children. If you need to send supplies or a change of clothes, please bring in a clear Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name and instructions.
- Those children who are still using bottles or sippy cups may have a second Ziploc bag (please label cups, bottles, and snack items) labeled with child's name and instructions.
- No food or drink allowed except for babies and toddlers.
- Teachers of infants will wear smocks to provide a clean fabric between the baby and teacher's clothing.
- Teachers will use gloves when diapering and following a good hand washing hygiene. Changing tables will be cleaned and sanitized after each use. These are already practiced procedures.
- Toys that are used by a child will be removed and sanitized before another child uses it.
- Individual bags of supplies for each child will be prepared to minimize sharing.
- Furniture and toys have been condensed to assist with disinfecting. Classrooms will be set up to promote social distancing.
- Indoor playground will remain closed. Children will stay in their classroom.
- Facilities crew will clean and disinfect each classroom before and after use.
