Head

We will study the Bible each and every week. There is nothing more powerful, impactful, or transformative in your life as a disciple than the Word of God. Our teachers will focus each week on helping you better understand the truths and principles of God's Word so you can rightly apply (obey) them to your life.

Heart

People were created for relationships. As you study the Bible with other believers, you will also grow in your relationships with them. "Doing life together," as we call it means that you will put into practice the "one another" commands of the New Testament. You will have the opportunity to love, care, and minister to others in your class as well as be ministered to in your time of need.

Hands

A call to follow Jesus is a call to serve. There is a special – powerful, even supernatural – bond that occurs when people serve others in the name of Jesus. Your class will inspire, encourage, and challenge each other to work out your faith as each person uses his/her unique skills, abilities, and talents to serve others both in the body of Christ and in the world around us.

As you visit classes, keep these things in mind:

- Each class is unique and different. They will vary in size, age, teaching style, and even study topics. We encourage you to visit multiple classes, multiple times, to get a good sense of the group dynamics in each class.
- Each teacher (teaching team) will teach differently. Visit multiple times to get a good feel for the teacher(s) and the style of teaching within the class.
- Engage with others outside of class. Someone once said, "Relationships are spelled t-i-m-e." Get to know people outside of the class setting. Many classes are structured to include other forms of relational, interactive small groups (Life Groups). Ask about them when you visit.
